The Season Lent

All Catholics are encouraged to participate in the traditional Lenten practice of prayer, sacrifice, and almsgiving. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence - one full meal and two smaller meals for persons 18 through 59 years of age; no meat for persons 14 years and older. All Fridays during Lent are days of **abstinence** - no

meat for persons 14 years and older. There is no obligation to fast during the weekdays of Lent; however, voluntary acts of self-denial are encouraged.
